Intercession is to intervene or mediate between two parties as the equal _____ of both.

Ezekiel 22:30 *"I looked for someone among them who would build up the wall and stand before me in the gap on behalf of the land so I would not have to destroy it, but I found no one."*

Intercessors are those who stand in that gap, mediating between heaven and earth as equal friends of both, talking _____ on behalf of the people, and _____ on behalf of God.

Exodus 32:11-13 *But Moses sought the favor of the Lord his God. "Lord," he said, "why should your anger burn against your people, whom you brought out of Egypt with great power and a mighty hand? ¹² Why should the Egyptians say, 'It was with evil intent that he brought them out, to kill them in the mountains and to wipe them off the face of the earth'? Turn from your fierce anger; relent and do not bring disaster on your people. Remember...*

Exodus 32:14 *Then the Lord relented and did not bring on his people the disaster he had threatened.*

Hebrews 7:25 *Therefore he is able to save completely those who come to God through him, because he always lives to intercede for them.*

Romans 8:26-27 *In the same way, the Spirit helps us in our weakness. We do not know what we ought to pray for, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us through wordless groans. ²⁷ And he who searches our hearts knows the mind of the Spirit, because the Spirit intercedes for God's people in accordance with the will of God.*
