## Feast of \_\_\_\_\_ - Feast of Tabernacles - Sukköt - Feast of Ingathering

Leviticus 23:33-34, 40-43 And the LORD/Yahweh said to Moses, 34"Speak to the Israelites and say, 'On the fifteenth day of the seventh month the Feast of Tabernacles to the LORD/Yahweh begins, and it continues for seven days....40On the first day you are to gather the fruit of majestic trees, the branches of palm trees, and the boughs of leafy trees and of willows of the brook. And you are to rejoice before the LORD/Yahweh your God for seven days. 41You are to celebrate this as a feast to the LORD/Yahweh for seven days each year. This is a permanent statute for the generations to come; you are to celebrate it in the seventh month. 42You are to dwell in booths for seven days. All the native-born of Israel must dwell in booths, 43so that your descendants may know that I made the Israelites dwell in booths when I brought them out of the land of Egypt. I am the LORD/Yahweh your God.'"
