5. \_\_\_\_\_ - Drivers and Expressives more extroverted; Analyticals and Amiables more introverted.

## Social Styles in Leadership

Analytical Leader - \_\_\_\_\_ and self-disciplined, making decisions logically and carefully. Can handle large amounts of details simultaneously.

Danger: Being too nitpicky/perfectionist.

Driver Leader - they get things done and are the most \_\_\_\_\_. They are visionaries and agents of change.

Danger: Being a human tornado, bossy, stubborn, demanding, and impatient.

Danger: Avoiding disciplining employees or terminating them.

Expressive Leader - \_\_\_\_\_, optimistic, good at stimulating action.

***Luke 7:7-10 That is why I did not even consider myself worthy to come to you. But say the word, and my servant will be healed. For I myself am a man under authority, with soldiers under me. I tell this one, 'Go,' and he goes; and that one, 'Come,' and he comes. I say to my servant, 'Do this,' and he does it." When Jesus heard this, he was amazed at him, and turning to the crowd following him, he said, "I tell you, I have not found such great faith even in Israel." Then the men who had been sent returned to the house and found the servant well.***

***Matt 3:13-15 Then Jesus came from Galilee to the Jordan to be baptized by John. But John tried to deter him, saying, "I need to be baptized by you, and do you come to me?" Jesus replied, "Let it be so now; it is proper for us to do this to fulfill all righteousness." Then John consented.***
