• To God -
Romans 12:1 Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship.
• To the world - refuse
Romans 12:2 Do not conform to the pattern of this world, but be transformed by the renewing of your mind. Then you will be able to test and approve what God's will is—his good, pleasing and perfect will.
• To ourselves - honestly .
Romans 12:3be honest in your evaluation of yourselves, measuring yourselves by the faith God has given us.
• To other Christians - love .
Romans 12:9-13 Don't just pretend to love others. Really love them. Hate what is wrong. Hold tightly to what good. 10 Love each other with genuine affection, and take delight in honoring each other. 11 Never be lazy, but work hard and serve the Lord enthusiastically. 12 Rejoice in our confident hope. Be patient in trouble, and keep on praying. 13 When God's people are in need, be ready to help them. Always be eager to practice hospitality.
