Conviction	Condemnation
Definite and Specific. The Lord tells you exactly what you have done.	Indefinite and vague. I feel guilty but can't identify any specific sin.
Recognizable. It is something unconfessed and unforgiven that I recognize - usually in the immediate past.	Imaginary - I can't put my finger on it. Or something from my past I've already taken care of through repentance and forgiveness that Satan is still trying to condemn me for.
Definite solution. The Holy Spirit tells me how to take care of the sin. When I obey, I get relief from guilt.	Usually no solution. If any solution is offered it is irrational and unscriptural. Guilt intensifies. No relief.
